MUSEUM AND PARK PASS BORROWING POLICY

The Woodward Memorial Library has two Genesee Country Village & Museum passes, two passes to the Rochester Museum & Science Center, and four NYS Empire Passes to circulate.

Borrowers must be at least 18 years old and have a valid Nioga Library card.

Passes must be checked out at <u>and</u> returned to WML. Passes must be <u>returned inside</u> to the circulation desk.

Passes <u>cannot</u> be returned in the book drop and <u>cannot</u> be returned to other libraries in the Nioga system.

Passes may not be put on hold.

Pass may be checked out for 7 days and cannot be renewed. If a Pass is lost or damaged beyond use there is an \$40 replacement fee.

Pass must be in the building for 24 hours before that same patron/family can check it out again.

One pass per person/family at a time.

The Empire Pass allows free admission to many parks in the state. The Woodward Memorial Library (WML) has four Empire Passes in circulation.

The Genesee Country Village & Museum Pass allows free admission to the museum during the season for two adults and all dependent children/grandchildren 18 years old and younger.

The Rochester Museum & Science Center allows free admission for two adults plus any children under 18 in their household to the RMSC in Rochester, the Cumming Nature Center in Naples, and free or discounted admission to shows at the Strasenburgh Planetarium.

How to check out a pass:

- Ask for the pass you would like at the circulation desk on the main floor of the Library.
- If one is available you can check it out just like you would any other item at the Library.
- The pass will come in a case and needs to be returned in a case.
