New Business:

- <u>Bero Proposal:</u> The board discussed talking to a third architecture company and will make a decision at the end of January on how to move forward.
- <u>Facilities Update</u>: Lynda suggested a standing monthly meeting with the school facilities director
 just to go over concerns and questions. Betsy will reach out to PJ and Brian to suggest this. The
 school is currently working with vendors and waiting on parts and equipment to do the
 permanent repair for the boiler valve that keeps sticking.
- <u>Trust Resolution from 2011</u>: Mary shared that in 2011 a resolution by the school board transferred all control of the Rivas Trust to the library, including having funds come directly to the library. The board decided there is no purpose in pursing this at this time as there would be no benefit from changing how things are being handled.
- <u>Cole Adams Attorney Proposal:</u> The board approved the proposal from the Law Offices of Stephanie Adams to have all of the library policies gone over. Betsy will also ask to have them look at the wills.
